This co-created school experience splits your time between self-led sessions and instructed activities. We believe in learning by doing and embedding knowledge through experience; we believe that education should be practical and hands-on wherever possible. In this school experience we work with you to design a programme that uses your curriculum expertise and our know-how in the outdoors to ensure that your pupils haven't just read about it – they've lived it.

Our activity sessions can either be used to directly support your work (eg trajectories based on archery competitions, or sedimentary geology based on a day of caving), or to help you deliver parts of a course which you cannot deliver yourself (eg running your own map skills orienteering sessions but asking us to deliver a climbing session). With either approach this is an opportunity to bring learning to life and create a truly bespoke programme tailored exactly to your needs.
