All of our activity sessions are instructed by a member of our activities team. They can accommodate a maximum of 12 participants plus 1 supervising adult. Session timings incorporate briefing and debriefing time.

Please check the suitability of activities for your group at the time of booking. A weight limit of 120Kg (18 Stone) applies to all roped activities.

Activity participants must dress appropriately for the activity. This includes closed-toe footwear, covered shoulders, no jewellery, and hair tied back. Please dress for the weather.

Self-instructed and self-led activities are available at our standard session times and should be booked in advance. All supervision is carried out by the leader.

Where qualifications are required for self-instructed sessions the qualification should be presented for staff to check before the session can begin.

Activities in a box are available on request at any time during reception opening hours but are subject to availability. Boxes should be booked in advance whenever possible.
