Self-instructed and self-led activities are available at our standard session times and should be booked in advance. All risk assessment and supervision is carried out by the Leader.

Where permits are required for self-instructed sessions the permit should be recorded on Compass for staff to check before the session can begin.

Activities in a box are available on request at any time during reception opening hours but are subject to availability. Boxes should be booked in advance whenever possible.
