ORIGINAL OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE

1 Night	£55	Built on 111 years of Scouting experience, this immersive residential focuses on learning by doing and developing skills for life. Based in our tented village and working in small teams, pupils complete 3 hour practical sessions in activities like Climbing, Orienteering, Bushcraft and Raft Building. Pupils cook their own evening meal over embers on the final night before a campfire led by their Camp Leader.

NOTES FOR PACKAGES

Peak & Off Peak

Day visits have a Peak, and Off Peak season. Peak is from 1st April to 30 September, all other times are Off Peak.

Free Adult Places

For every 10 young people we will give you 1 free place for an accompanying adult. Accompanying adults are responsible for pastoral care of young people at all times including during instructed activities. Further additional adults will be charged at 50%.

Tented Village

The Tented Village is equipped with mattress pads and storage boxes. You will sleep in traditional bell tents, with separate tents for teachers.

Activity Programme

With Outdoor Adventure and Original Outdoor Experience, you'll receive a full programme of adventurous activities and an evening session each night. Activities are in groups of 12 plus 1 accompanying adult. There are 5 activity sessions per day, 2 in the morning, 2 in the afternoon and one in the evening. One of your evening sessions may be a Teacher led session – where the centre provides the resources for your teaching staff to run an activity.

Catering

Catering consists of 3 meals per day, starting with an evening meal on your arrival day, and finishing with lunch on your departure. Please speak to us about dietary requirements early on in the booking process.

Local Attractions

If you take the Adventure 50:50 option there are numerous local educational attractions including Monkey World, Bovington Tank Museum and The Jurassic Coast.
