All of our activity sessions are. Each session can accommodate a maximum of 12 participants. 1 adult will be required for supervision. Session timings incorporate travel, briefing and debriefing time.

Please check the suitability of activities for your group at the time of booking. A weight limit of 120 Kg (18 stone) applies to all roped activities.

Self-instructed and self-led activities are available at our standard session times and should be booked in advance. All risk assessment and supervision is carried out by the Leader.

Where permits are required for self-instruct sessions the permit should be recorded on Compass for staff to check before the session can begin.

Activities in a Box are available on request at any time during reception opening hours but are subject to availability. Boxes should be booked in advance whenever possible.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Brownsea Island – The location of the very first Scout Camp, just 30minutes away and now owned by the National Trust.

Monkey World – Just 10 minutes away is the famous Monkey World sanctuary and ape rescue centre. Ideal for group visits.

Bovington Tank Museum – Only a 10 minute drive. With over 300 exhibitions that tell the story of armoured warfare from World War One to the present day.

The Jurassic Coast – from Lulworth cove and Durdle Door to Poole harbour, this stunning coast line is less than 30 minutes, drive. Perfect for sea kayaking, coastal hikes or cycling.
