#### NOTES FOR PACKAGES

<b>Peak &amp; Off Peak</b>	Peak season is from 1 <sup>st</sup> June to 31 <sup>st</sup> August, all other times are Off Peak.
<b>Free Adult Places</b>	For every 10 young people we will give you 1 free place for an accompanying adult. Accompanying adults are responsible for pastoral care of young people at all times including during instructed activities. Further additional adults will be charged at 50%.
<b>Accommodation</b>	Each package includes your choice of indoor or tented accommodation. Accommodation is available from 17:00 on day of arrival to 11:00 on day of departure. Luggage can be stored outside of these times if your programme starts earlier or finishes later.
<b>Tented Village</b>	The Tented Village is equipped with mattress pads and storage boxes. You will sleep in traditional bell tents, with separate tents for teachers.
<b>Activity Programme</b>	With Outdoor Adventure and Original Outdoor Experience, you'll receive a full programme of adventurous activities and an evening session each night. Activities are in groups of 12 plus 1 accompanying adult. There are 5 activity sessions per day, 2 in the morning, 2 in the afternoon and one in the evening. One of your evening sessions may be a Teacher led session – where the centre provides the resources for your teaching staff to run an activity.
<b>Catering</b>	Catering consists of 3 meals per day, starting with an evening meal on your arrival day, and finishing with lunch on your departure. Please speak to us about dietary requirements early on in the booking process. Please note, catering is not included in a day visit.
<b>Local Attractions</b>	If you opt for the Adventure 50:50 package there are numerous local educational attractions nearby including Bowness and Windermere, Mountain bike hire and South Lakes Safari Zoo.
