NOTES FOR PACKAGES

Peak Season	Peak season is from 1 st April to 31 st October, all other times are off peak.
Adult Places	For every 10 young people we will give you 1 free place for an accompanying adult. Accompanying adults are responsible for pastoral care of young people at all times including during instructed activities. Additional adults will be charged at 50% of the package price.
Accommodation	Each package includes your choice of indoor or tented accommodation. Accommodation is available from 16:00 on day of arrival to 13:00 on day of departure. If you plan to arrive early or leave late, we can offer you a classroom to store your equipment / bags for just £50 for the day. This includes free tea and coffee.
Tented Village	The Tented Village is equipped with mattress pads. Tents can sleep up to 4 people. There is also a communal marquee to be used as a dining area and camp kitchen with seating, electric and lighting. Separate tents are provided for teachers.
Activity Programme	With Outdoor Adventure and Original Outdoor Experience, you'll receive a full programme of adventurous activities and an evening session each night. You will be looked after by one of our programme leaders who will ensure that everything runs smoothly throughout your stay. Activities are in groups of 12 plus 1 accompanying adult. There are 5 activity sessions per day, 2 in the morning, 2 in the afternoon and 1 in the evening.
Catering	Catering consists of 3 meals per day, starting with an evening meal on your arrival day, and finishing with lunch on your departure. We are able to cater for most dietary requirements, so please do let us know. Please note, catering is not included in a day visit.
Local Attractions	If you opt for the Adventure 50:50 package there are numerous local educational attractions nearby including the Olympic White Water Centre at Lee Valley and the wilds of Epping Forrest.
