About the building

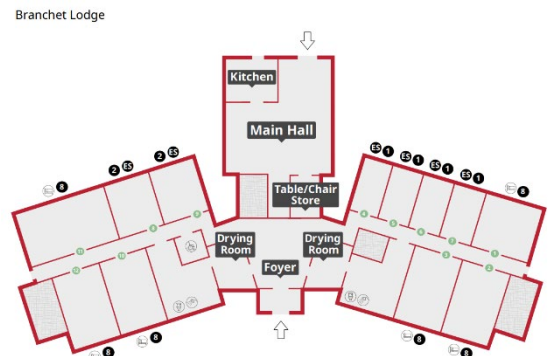
Branchet is a modern, bright lodge sleeping up to 56 people. The building has six eight-bed dorms, two twin en-suite rooms, and four single en-suite rooms. Two twin rooms in the building are accessible, with accessible washrooms. There are shared bathrooms in both wings of the building with toilets, sinks and showers and an additional accessible bathroom.

Beds are provided mattress-only, so **make sure you bring a sleeping bag and pillow.**

The building has a commercial kitchen with everything you need to cater for a group of 56 people.

There's a large hall for dining or activities in with tables and chairs to seat your group. The hall is equipped with a screen and AV system for any activities or just watching a film.

There's a foyer space with sofas for leaders to relax in the evening; and two drying rooms for muddy boots and wet coats.



What's included?

Kitchen appliances:

- Full fridge and full freezer
- Catering oven with electric induction hob
- Electrical kettle, microwave, toaster
- Commercial sanitiser (not dishwasher)

Kitchen equipment:

- Induction frying pans and saucepans in a variety of sizes for group catering
- Chopping Boards, colanders, bowls, baking trays
- Basic Utensils – knives, spoon, spatula, tongs, slotted spoon, ladle, tin opener, cheese grater
- Plates, bowls, cups and cutlery for the lodge capacity

Cleaning:

- We provide non-consumable cleaning equipment - brooms, dustpans, mops etc.
- **You'll need to bring your own cleaning sprays, cloths, washing up liquid and anything else you might need.**
- We stock all our toilets with toilet roll and hand soap.

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
