

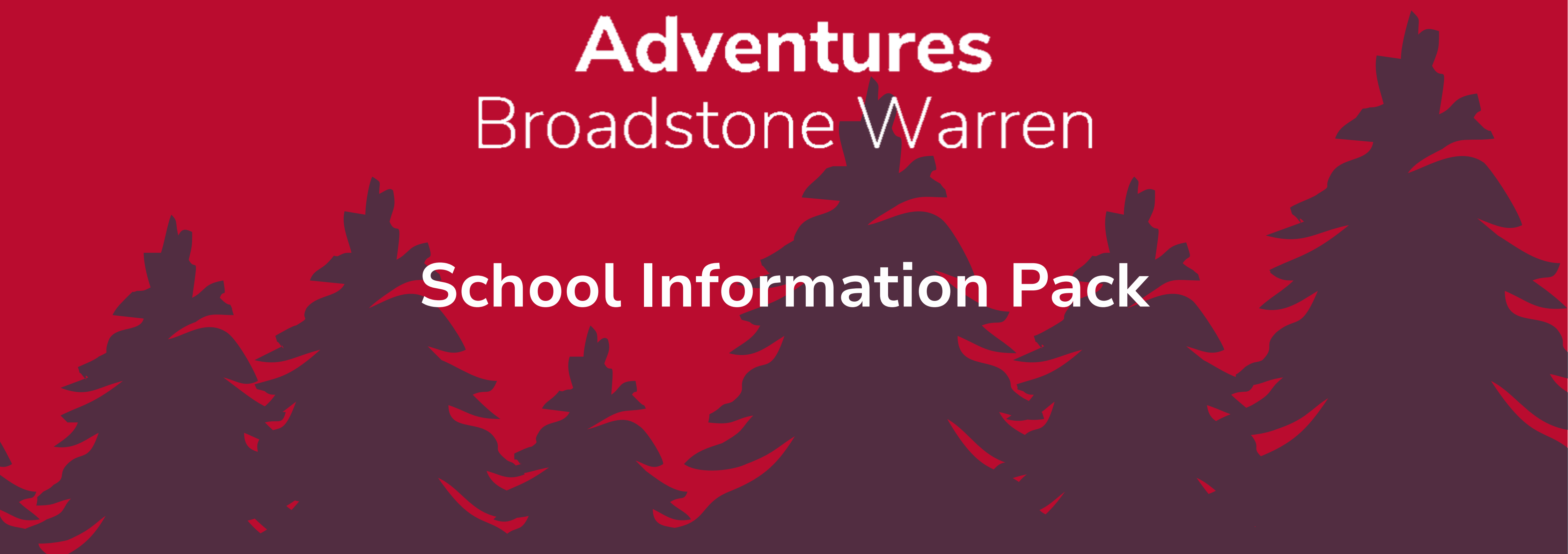

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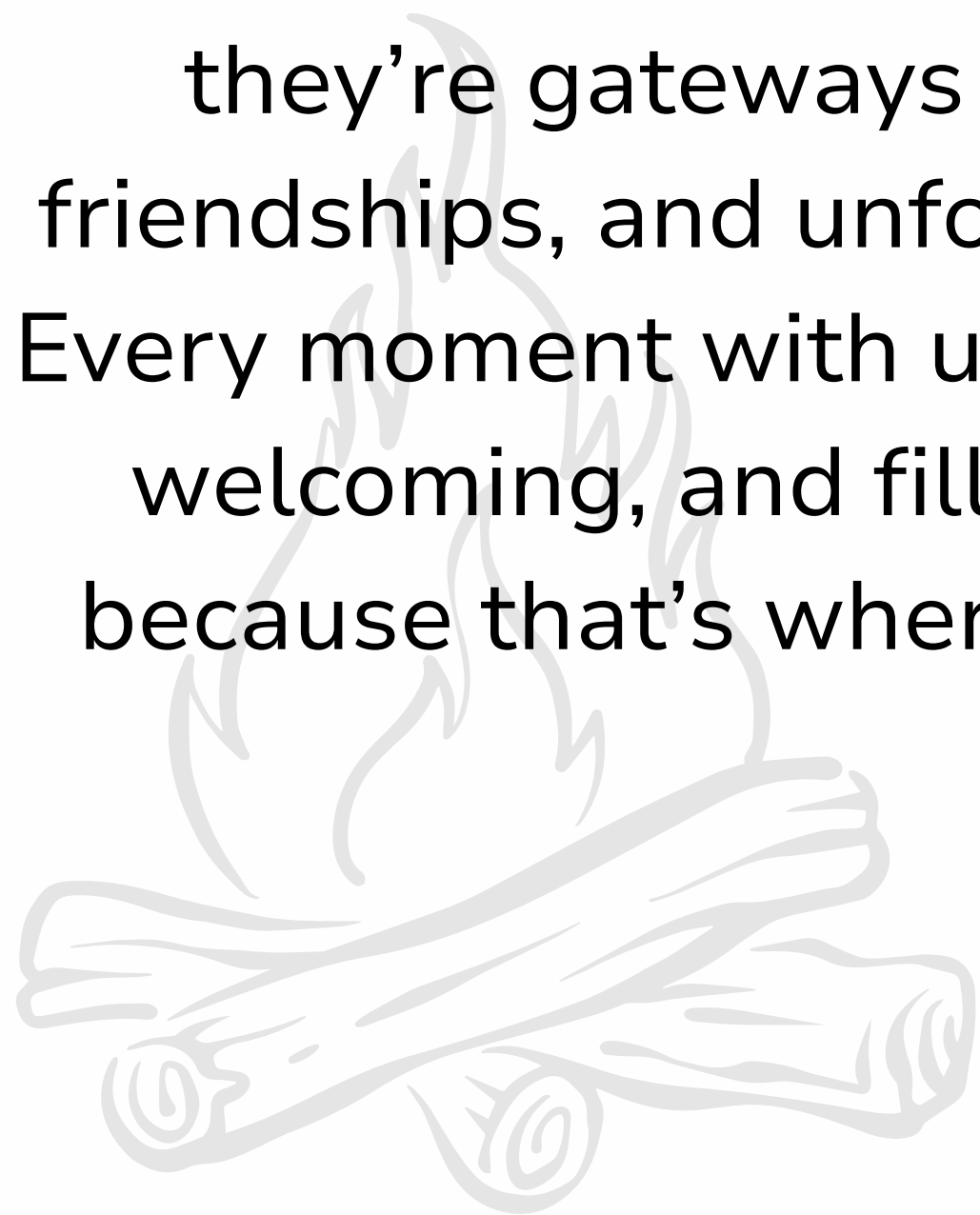

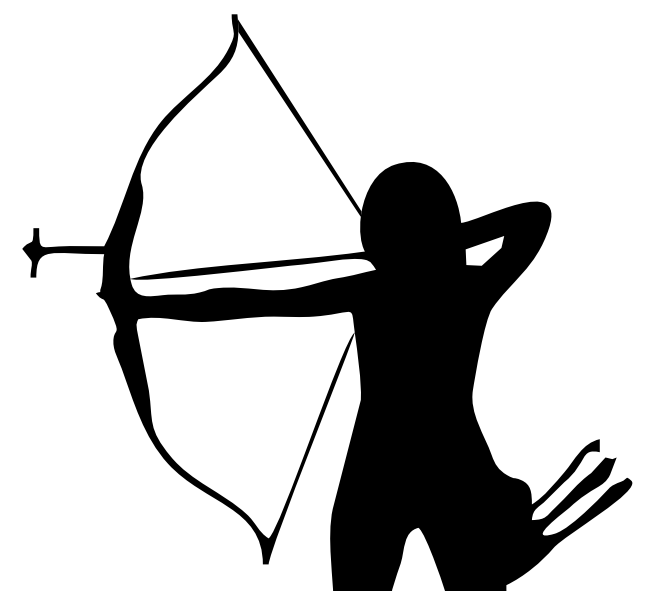

School staff remain with their groups in the same building or camping area throughout their stay. Our accommodation buildings can be securely locked from the inside, offering peace of mind overnight.

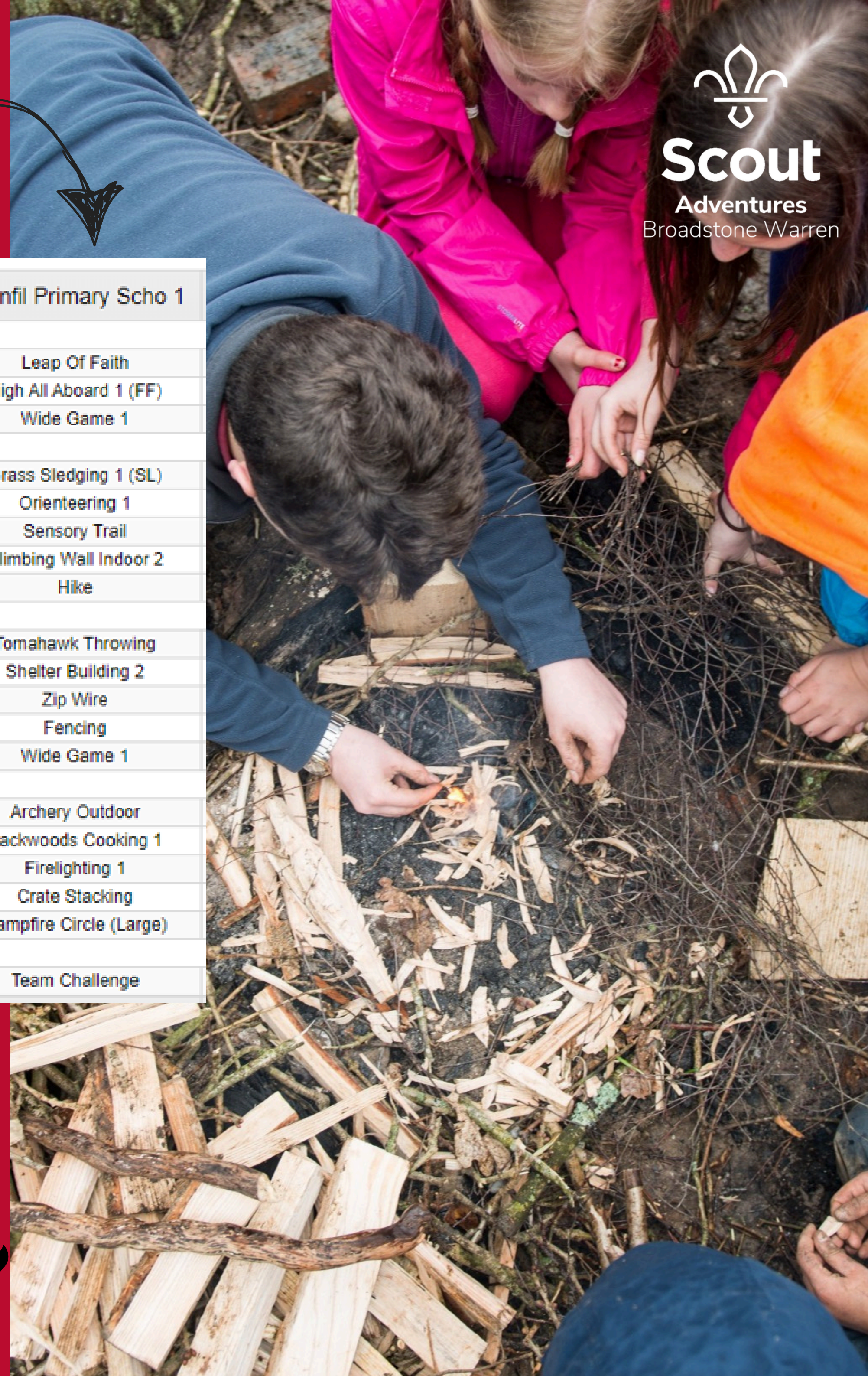

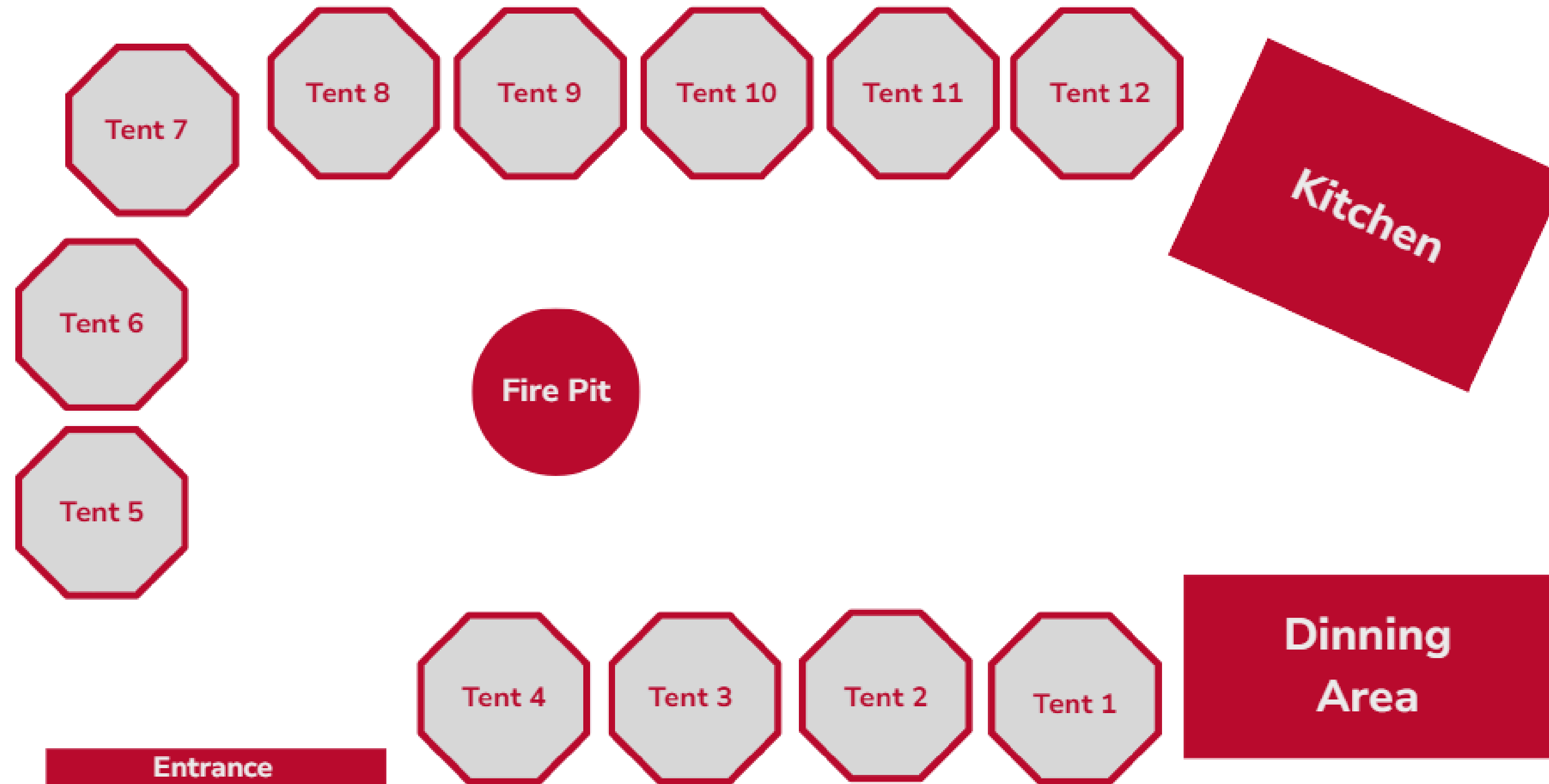

Meal Times and Locations

Catering is currently available for guests staying in Broadstone Lodge or our Tented Village, with plans to expand in the future.

Guests are responsible for serving own meals in accommodation areas, and washing up afterwards.

Breakfast and lunch will get dropped off with dinner the night before so you have everything you need in advance for the day head.



What to Know Before You Go!

Before you arrive, please let us know about any dietary needs so we can make sure everyone's happy and well-fed. Lunch isn't provided on arrival day, so bring something tasty to eat.

Your teachers will handle any medication, but if something might affect your activities, just let us know — we're here to help!

No need to bring snacks either — we'll keep you well-fed.
