What is Adventure for All?

At Scout Adventures we're all about helping young people to do their best. We believe that nights away can have a powerful, positive impact on young people's development – both socially and educationally.

We're providing 1,000 fully funded places on a 3 day, 2 night residential at one of our centres. The funding includes the cost of accommodation, catering and an activity programme – the only thing not included is the cost of transport to the Centre.

How do we take part?

We're inviting applications from Scout, school and Guide Groups (not individuals). You can apply by completing an online form with details about your group and a supporting statement explaining the impact the residential would have on your young people.

Who is eligible?

Young people should be aged between 6 and 18 and you must be able to provide accompanying adults on a ratio of 1 adult to every 12 young people. All groups are welcome to apply but we will prioritise places for groups for whom a residential will have the biggest impact. The full eligibility criteria for our priority list can be found on our website.

When can residential take place?

Residential can take place at weekends or mid-week. Once your application has been approved you can book your residential following our normal process – all funded residential must be completed by the 31st March 2022.

Connecting Young People to Nature

The Scouts have joined forces with some of the UK's best known outdoor learning charities and organisations to help inspire a generation of young people to connect to the outdoors.

Generation Green is a 16-month funded project that aims to create opportunities for thousands of young people to connect with nature.

Through new jobs, training, volunteering roles, residential, outdoor and online learning experiences, the project will provide more than 100,000 opportunities to connect young people to nature – many for the first time – and to cultivate a sense of care for the natural environment.

This project is funded by the government's Green Recovery Challenge Fund. The fund is being delivered by The National Lottery Heritage Fund in partnership with Natural England and the Environment Agency.



Generation Green is the first project to be delivered by the Access Unlimited coalition. The coalition comprises of YHA (England & Wales) – who are hosting the project on behalf of the partners - The Outward Bound Trust, Scouts, Girlguiding, Field Studies Council and the 10 English National Parks.

Arrival and Departure

Mid-week groups usually arrive at lunch time on day 1 and depart at lunchtime on day 3. Weekend groups will usually arrive on a Friday evening and depart after lunch on Sunday. We'll agree exact timings with you when you book.

Accommodation

There are 2 options available at most of our sites – you can stay indoors in one of our lodges or you can spend the night under canvas in our purpose built tented villages.

Catering

We'll provide catering from the first meal after your arrival until your departure. Mid-week residential should plan to bring a packed lunch for lunch on day 1. We can cater for most dietary needs and requirements with enough notice.

Activity Programme

We'll agree the programme with you but it will be a blend of instructed activity and leader led activity – this mix produces the greatest impact for young people. We will provide at least 6 hours of instructed activity sessions and provide equipment or resources for at least 3 more hours of structured activity. We have deliberately allowed some free time for young people to play and explore the safe environment of our centres.

How to Apply

1. Apply

2. Book

We'll contact you to tell you if your application has been approved. You can then book your residential following our normal process – agreeing dates, programme and location with our customer support team.

3. Adventure

You travel to one of our centres and take part in an amazing adventure!
