Baines & Barrow Banks

Sites

- Wam, Gee and Wig,
- Baines I,
- Baines II,
- Bally Strain and Hurle Foot,
- Brant, Dodd, Doup, Ash Beck and Sike

These sites are remote, undulating, medium size sites set in thick woodland away from the main site. The area is excellent for survival and bushcraft, and gives the feel of wild camping. Sites are accessed on foot but can be accessed from the road to drop off equipment.

Stand Pipe

On site or within a 5 minute walk.

Toilets & Showers

Minimum 25 minute walk to facilities at camp centre. You may wish to bring a portable toilet

Reception & Shop

Minimum 25 minute walk.

Parking

Sites are accessed through West Gate where you will find a small area where an emergency vehicle may be parked. All other vehicles should be parked at the site's main car park.
