## Learning Outcomes

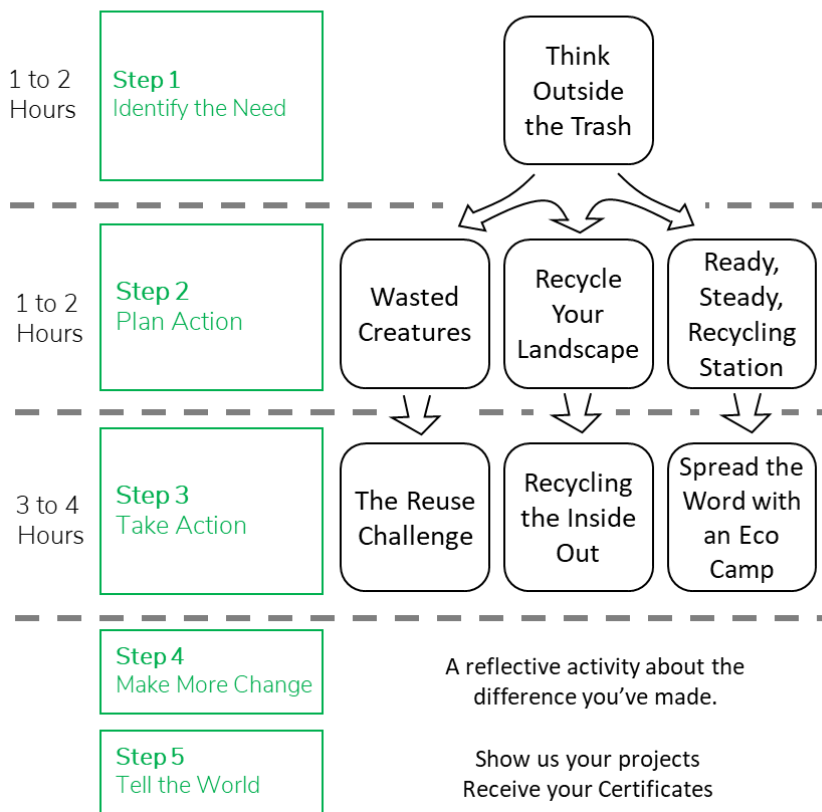
### Learning Outcomes
